

LANGLEY PARISH COUNCIL

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

1. Members of the public are asked to respect the fact that this is a meeting to conduct council business and interruptions during council business are not permitted. If in the opinion of the Chairman, the business of the meeting is disrupted in any way, the Chairman will ask the person/s causing the disruption to be quiet and if they refuse, then they will be asked to leave.
2. The Public Participation session will take place for a maximum of 15 minutes and each resident may only speak for a maximum of 3 minutes. If members of the public wish for a more detailed dialogue than the 3 minutes allowed, then they should contact the Chairman or other Councillor for an individual discussion: the Parish Council meeting is not the correct forum for conducting debates between councillors and members of the public. Supplementary comments and questions are solely at the discretion of the Chairman.
3. Members of the public should be aware that if questions are raised which relates to topics not on the agenda and falls within the remit of the Parish Council, then the matter is more likely to be deferred for a subsequent response as investigation may be required
